PRESS RELEASE

June 16, 2013

On 6-16-2013, at about 1625 hours, officers from the Pacifica Police Department responded to the area of Palmetto Ave. and Montecito Dr. on the report of a possible attempted child abduction of a 10 year old female.

Upon arrival, officers contacted the victim and her parents. The victim reported that while in the area of Beach Blvd. and Santa Rosa Ave., a male subject approached her and told her that she was coming with him. When the victim refused, the suspect attempted to physically gain control of her. The victim punched the suspect and was able to flee.

The suspect was seen last running on Santa Rosa Ave. towards Palmetto Ave. The victim was not injured in this incident. Officers checked the immediate area but did not locate the suspect.

The suspect is described as a white male adult, 30-40 years old, brown hair, 6-0' tall, stocky build and tan complexion. He was wearing blue jeans, a red checkered shirt and black shoes.

The investigation into this incident is continuing by the Pacifica Police Department.
